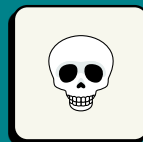


Decoding emojis

Smiling face with hand over mouth:
Playful, flirtatious.



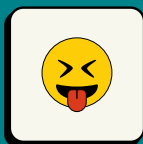
Skull:
Dying with laughter.



Smiling face with tongue:
Playful, flirtatious.



Monkey face:
Playful, flirtatious.



Squinting face with tongue:
Playful, flirtatious.



Dove:
Deep feelings.



Hot (Hot face with tongue out and dripping sweat): Someone or something is hot and steamy.



Double exclamation:
High level of excitement.



Smiling cat with heart eyes:
Strong feelings of love for something or someone.



Collision:
Implying chemistry together.



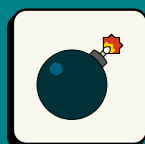
Horny Devil:
Flirtatious, playful or cheeky.



Fire:
Flirtatious, you're "hot".

**Pizza:**

Like, love you.

**Dynamite:**

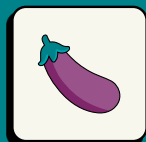
Support for misogynist or harmful ideas, explosive or extreme opinion.

**Chilli pepper:**

Spiciness, excitement. Someone or something is hot or attractive.



100: Related to the 80/20 rule which suggests 80% of women are attracted to 20% of men.

**Eggplant:**

Male penis, flirtatious contexts.

**Two hearts:**

Appreciation, platonic love.

**Birthday cake:**

If not being used to celebrate a birthday it implies someone's bottom.

**Blue heart:**

Platonic love, support for mental health.

**Noodles:**

"Nudes" - explicit or intimate photos or videos.

**Purple heart:**

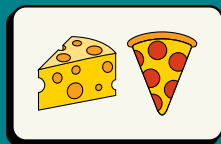
Intense physical attraction.

**Corn:**

Pornography.

**Yellow heart:**

Friendship or platonic affection.

**Cheese + Pizza:**

Child pornography or content involving the sexual exploitation of children.

**Green heart:**

Envy, jealousy, or an interest in nature/ environmental causes.

**Kidney beans:**

Support for misogynist or harmful ideas.

**Red heart:**

Love, deep affection, and romantic feelings.
